## TEMPLE SHAAREI SHALOM OPENS A WHOLE NEW WORLD FOR PRE-KINDERGARTNERS WITH *RISHONIM* CLASS ON SUNDAY MORNINGS

( [REDACTED] — Just as *Rishonim* means “beginners” in Hebrew, pre-kindergarten children ages 3 ½ to young five year-olds will start their Jewish education at Temple Shaarei Shalom with fun, music and art led by early childhood specialist Pam Jacobson, as well as special visits from the Temple’s clergy.

Classes start Sunday, September 8, 2013, 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and continue on the regular religious school schedule throughout the year. All children must be potty trained. Tuition is \$220. Reduced Temple membership rates are available for families whose oldest child is in grade pre-k through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
